Why should I take training?

You've already volunteered. Thanks! If you're going to do something, you should do it well. Training for your specific Scouting position provides the foundation for providing an exceptional program to our Scouts in just a few hours. Not only will you learn about how you can effectively use the methods of Scouting, but you'll get tools and resources to help make sure you – and your Scouts – are successful (and having fun).

What classes do I need to take to be considered fully trained?

It depends on your position.

Cubmaster and Assistant Cubmaster

- Youth Protection Training (online)
- Cubmaster and Assistant Cubmaster Position Specific Training (classroom and online)

Den Leader and Assistant Den Leader

- Youth Protection Training (online)
- Den Leader and Assistant Den Leader Position Specific Training (classroom) or the online version of the class

Cub Leaders wanting to keep the OUTING in SCOUTING

- Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)
- Outdoor Webelos Leader (OWL) training

Merit Badge Counselor

- Youth Protection Training (online)
- Merit Badge Counselor Orientation (classroom)

Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster

- SM/ASM Leader Specific (classroom and online)
- Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) – aka Blue Oak

There are plenty of other training opportunities available. But make sure you have these completed and you can wear the Trained patch on your uniform and be eligible to earn your leader knots.

Can I take the classes online?

In most cases, yes. The BSA has worked to provide extensive eLearning options. Classroom offerings are generally preferred by students because of the ability to meet peers and get insights into local challenges and opportunities.

I can't make it to any of those dates. What are my options?

In addition to the online options, the Twin Valley training staff will come to you! Do you have a group of new leaders that needs Youth Protection training? A group of parents that wants to be merit badge counselors? Maybe just a couple of den leaders looking to better understand the next rank?
