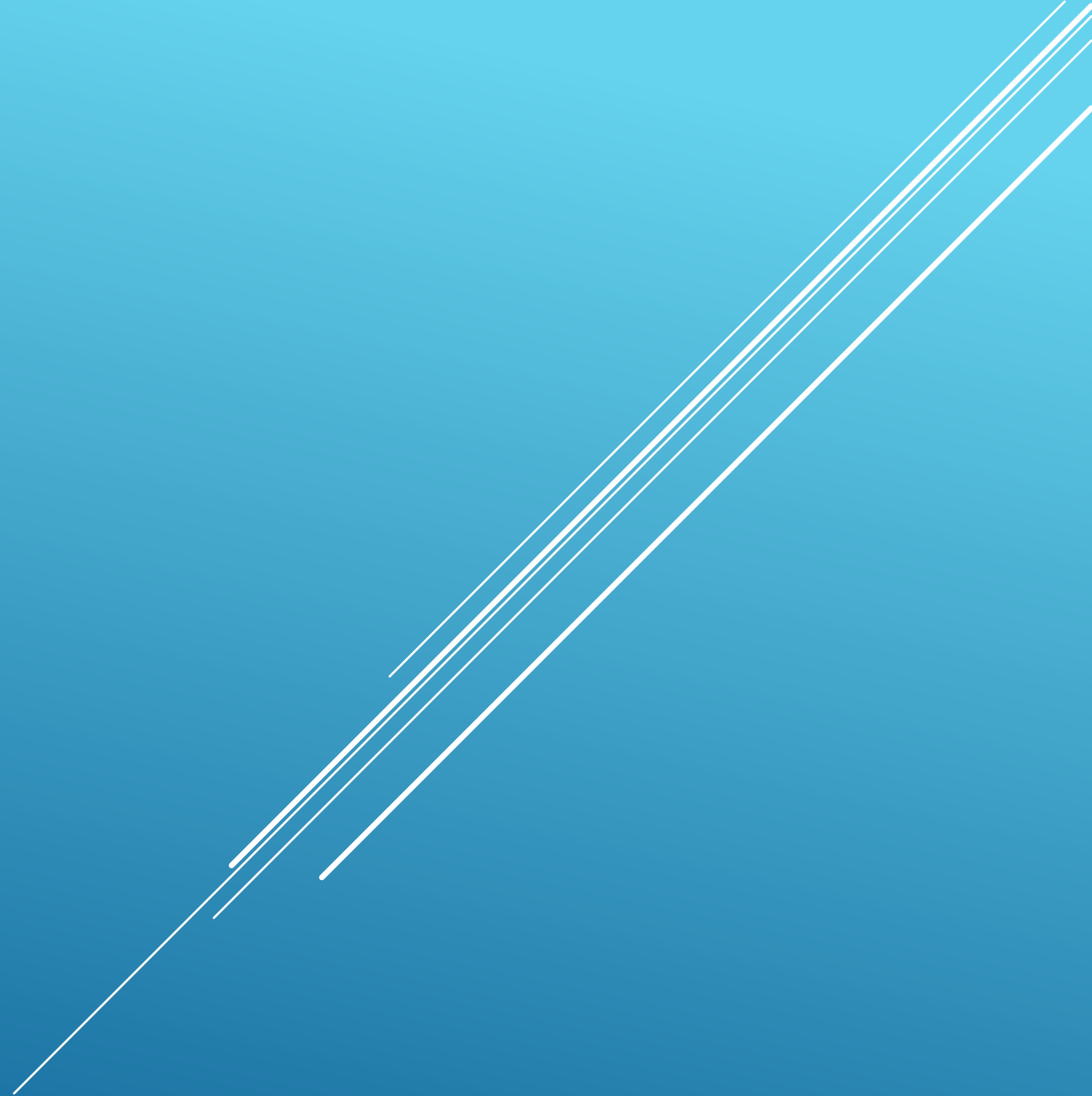

# WHAT WAS THE PAIA?

- ▶ Program Activities Insurance Assessment
- ▶ Created by Council Executive Board
- ▶ Purpose was to aid in Council staying solvent
- ▶ \$108 per Youth and \$12 per adult

# WHY HAVE THE PAIA?

- ▶ Rising cost of programming
- ▶ Loss of Corporate sponsorships
- ▶ Decline in donations
- ▶ Increased costs due to COVID
- ▶ Helps fund the bare minimum of activities



# PAIA IS NOW THE CPF

- ▶ Stands for Council Program Fee
- ▶ Due at Recharter to pay for upcoming year
- ▶ \$66 per registered youth (net decrease of \$42 vs PAIA)
- ▶ \$42 per registered adult (net increase \$30 vs PAIA)
- ▶ Multiples will not be double charged
  
- ▶ What will be due at recharter:
  - ▶ Youth:  $\$66 + \$66 + \text{BL } \$12 = \$132$  ( $\$132 / 12 = \$11$ )
  - ▶ Adult:  $\$42 + \$42 + \text{Sc } \$12 = \$84$

# WHAT ABOUT...

- ▶ What if my Pack or Troop already paid the PAIA?
  - ▶ Refund OR transfer over to CPF
- ▶ What if my Pack or Troop did an FOS event to help lower our PAIA?
